Planning Commission: Dan gave report. They all have their books. Appointed officers Tim Jammerath-Chair, Mindy Gallentine-Secty, Janita Fisher-Vice Secty. Need to get moving on Master Plan and Ordinance book. Need attorney to advise how to correct any that were not completed correctly. Per former secretary the Master Plan was finalized and sent to Williams and Werks.

LCEDA: Tony Gagliardo gave report. Housing study is done and are now looking to apply for financing to develop and implement a Lake Co Housing Plan. Meeting scheduled for 10/16/24 to bring all parties together to develop a plan on how to proceed.

On Going: Septic repair/replacement plan was discussed earlier as was the Grant info.

Planning Commission: 2 members are taking the Citizen Planner course. Considering having a class here in the spring as other members are not able to travel in the evening due to commitments.

Motion to approve \$89,059.00 invoice for road repair on 32nd St made by Deb with support by Dan. . Roll Call: Kelly-Yes, Pat-Yes, Dan-Yes, Deb-Yes, Howard-Absent. 4 Yes votes. 1 Absent. Motion carries. Pat will pull \$30,000 from the Shelby account to cover balance not available in the Road fund.

Pat made a motion to purchase two MTA red books for the Planning Commission with a maximum cost of \$150, with support by Dan. . Roll Call: Kelly-Yes, Pat-Yes, Dan-Yes, Deb-Yes, Howard-Absent. 4 Yes votes. 1 Absent. Motion carries.

GEO is requesting a new Tax Tribunal. We currently have our attorney working on this issue and will keep the public posted as to the outcome. Pat will run an impact spreadsheet.

Member of public asked if GEO is still dumping water to turn over the water in our water tower. We need Sam to give us an update on this.

Office computer issues seem to have be remedied with our new internet. Lisa's new computer is here.

We have only received 2 bids for the electrical service to the maintenance building.

There has been no action on a gate for the park.
