Seasonal Camping Permit Renewal & Requirements

This letter serves as a reminder to renew your annual camping permit for the _____ season (_____ 7).
To ensure compliance with local ordinances, please review the following requirements and deadlines:

Permit Fees and Zoning Regulations

- Annual Fee: A \$25 fee is required for each RV. **Payment is due by June 1, 2026.**
- **Residential 1 & 2 Districts:** One camper is permitted with a minimum of 9,000 sq. feet of land. Multiple campers are strictly prohibited on residential properties.
- **Recreational & Agricultural District:** Up to three campers are permitted on a minimum of one acre with required setbacks.

Application Requirements

To process your _____ application, you must provide the following Proof of Ownership.

- A clear copy of your current camper registration.
- A copy of your valid driver's license.
- ****If you have already provided this information and is the same; you DO NOT need to send it in again.**

Police Power Ordinance & Mandatory Inspections

- Per the Police Power Ordinance, all campers must remain roadworthy and in good repair.
- All RV/Travel Trailers may be inspected prior to issuing a _____, Camping Permit.

Compliance

- Permits will not be granted for any unit deemed not roadworthy or in poor condition until all necessary repairs are completed.

Permit Display

- Your permit must be clearly visible from the road at all times.
- Post the permit inside a window of the RV facing the road or at the driveway entrance where visible.

Trash Pick-Up

- Republic provides trash collection for campers that have a valid address and a current camping permit.
- If you need to obtain a valid address, contact the Equalization Department at (231) 745-2723.
- To request a bin, contact Webber Township Treasurer at (231) 349-4860.

Payment

Webber Township currently does not accept electronic payments. Please mail (or stop by the office) a check or money order made out to Webber Township along with application and registration information (if applicable) and a receipt along with your permit will be mailed back to you to be displayed as stated above.
