An Ordinance to protect the public health, safety and welfare by the delineation of streets upon which no parking is permitted; and to provide an effective date.

ORDAINS:

SECTION 1

PURPOSE, TITLE, ENABLING AUTHORITY

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Webber Township No Parking Ordinance and is adopted pursuant to Act 246 of 1945 (MCL 41.181 et seq.); and Section 674 of Act 300 of 1949 (1)(w); (MCL 257.674 (1)(w)). The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the public health, safety and welfare; to keep certain roads clear for traffic movement; and to conserve township and county public safety resources by the designation of certain no parking areas within the Township.

SECTION 2
DEFINITIONS

The following definitions apply to this Ordinance:

"Parking" means standing a vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a street or the street right of way in Webber Township;

"Prohibited Parking" means parking a vehicle upon a street or street right of way which is identified by official signs establishing that parking is not permitted.

"Tow-away zone" means a zone where parking, stopping, or standing is not permitted, as indicated by proper signs, and where vehicles parked in violation of the signs are towed away to keep the roadway clear for traffic movement.

SECTION 3
PROHIBITION ON PARKING AND DESIGNATION OF NO PARKING AREAS

It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle at any time within either side of the street right-of-way on any of the following designated "no parking" areas:

1. S. James Road from 36th street to the north end of the 3600 block thereof.
2. W. 32nd Street from M37 to Michway Rd.
3. S. Michway Road between w 36th Street and W 32nd Street.
4. W 36th Street from S. James Road West to Michway.
5. W. Ontario Street.
6. W Erie Street.
7. W Huron Street.
8. S. Roosevelt Road.
9. S. Holley Avenue and its southern extension.
10. S. Sheridan Ave. between W. 32nd and W 36th Streets.
11. S Guthrie Blvd. between W. Springtime Street and W 36th Street.

Such "no parking" areas are hereby designated as "tow away zones". A police officer shall be permitted to take any such illegally parked vehicle into custody. The procedures in MCI 257.252a shall govern the reclaiming of such vehicle.

Prohibited parking areas are shown on the attached map, which is incorporated herein.

SECTION 4
SEVERABILITY

Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other part thereof other than the parts so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 5
REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Any proceedings pending, including prosecutions for violations, under any previous ordinance provision being repealed hereby shall not be affected by this Ordinance and may be continued pursuant to said previous Ordinance provisions.

SECTION 6
EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective the day after publication, after adoption.
