Fire Department:

Jeremy gave report. Joseph Ramos completed Firefighter 1 training=Pay increase to \$25 and Sam Bradley was promoted to Deputy Chief=Pay increase to \$35. Holly Bradley is new secretary and doing a very good job. She has started billing for fire calls, downed lines, etc.

S/W & Maintenance:

Rodney gave report. Failed pressure valve caused the water tank to overfill. Has been repaired. Need to run a service line to our Twp hall and Fire Hall so we don't experience outages during repairs in the future. Rodney will provide names of some contractors we can contact for bids.

Co. Road Commissioner:

Mr. Welford gave report. Handed out 211 pamphlets. Mentioned the land sales letters may be looking for data center land. He is pro tiny homes. Need more housing.

Pat will work with residents paying multiple refuse assessments.

Pat made a motion not to buy any of the “Right of first refusal” properties with support by Kelly. 5 Aye votes. Motion carries.

A non profit association plans to have a booth at Go Day and is asking if they can request donations at the event. After a discussion the board agreed they would prefer not to allow this. Go Day is a free community event.
